		or with a two-point advantage, and after 10-10, the serve
		alternates. The final result of an individual match can be 3-0,
		3-1, or 3-2. All rounds must be played through. Alongside the
		standings, an individual performance list is also maintained.
		Depending on the number and strength of participating teams,
		we organize the championship in one or two divisions. After any
		player's first individual match, they can be substituted with a
		designated substitute player before the match. Two substitutions
		are allowed per match. The team leader must indicate the
		substitution player's lineup before the substitution.

own risk participate in the tournament at their own risk. During the championship, a competitor can only play for one team. If they have already played for one team, they cannot play for another team in the remaining part of the championship. In order to ensure fair and clean execution of the championship, every team is obligated to compete in a sportsmanlike manner for victory or to achieve the best possible result in every match, even if the final outcome of the match does not significantly affect their ultimate ranking. The matches of the championship are held on 2-2 Joola 2000S tables. At the end of the championship, in case of a tie in points, the results achieved against each other will decide, the number of points obtained against each other, and then the set ratio will be considered. If all these are equal the result of the doubles match will decide the final placement

The champions will receive a trophy and teams in 1st-3rd place will receive a medal.
